



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

University of Sarajevo, Faculty of Architecture

AND

International Peace and Cooperation Center

Hereinafter referred to as the Parties,

I. Purpose

This is a Memorandum of Understanding between University of Sarajevo, Faculty of Architecture and the International Peace and Cooperation Center, Jerusalem, It aims:-

- To explore models of cross borders cooperation
- To Promote research and joint activities on cities in conflict and post conflict, and
- To draw positive and negative lessons from different cases and experiences.

II. General Provisions

A. Duration

This agreement is valid for a period of two years. This will be effective as of the acceptance and signature by both parties. It may be renewed by mutual agreement. Neither party will be able to suspend or cancel the operations of the agreement without first giving an account of their reasons and providing six months' notice. In all cases, should the agreement be declared suspended, this will not halt the activities already in progress.



B. Cooperation

Academic cooperation between all parties will be enhanced through:

- Benefiting from the distinguished expertise of both sides,
- Organizing joint workshops and exhibitions, and
- Explore funding possibilities and joint projects.

Cooperation for all joint activities will be based on the principle of mutuality. Same responsibilities will apply to all institutions in the workload.

This Agreement represents the entire understanding and agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.
